

The Teaching Speaking Process Using Google Meet Platform in Covid-19 Era

Abstrak

Tujuan penelitiannya adalah untuk menyelidiki guru yang menerapkan Google Meet dalam proses pengajaran berbicara dan untuk menyelidiki evaluasi teknik yang diterapkan oleh guru dalam proses pengajaran berbicara di Google Meet. Penelitian ini menggunakan desain penelitian wawancara yang dilakukan terhadap guru bahasa Inggris. Analisis data ditentukan oleh jenis data berdasarkan tujuan penelitian yaitu proses pengajaran speaking dan teknik evaluasi pengajaran speaking menggunakan Google Meet. Hasil dari penerapan Google Meet dalam proses pengajaran speaking adalah memberikan materi terlebih dahulu melalui platform lain seperti Google Classroom dan WhatsApp kemudian menggunakan Google Meet, evaluasi teknik yang diterapkan oleh guru dalam proses pengajaran speaking di Google Meet adalah tidak hanya sekedar mengatakan saja, tetapi ada tugas menulis yang harus dikumpulkan yang merupakan bagian dari evaluasi berbicara. Proses pengajaran speaking hanya menggunakan satu platform saja tidak cukup, namun harus dibantu dengan platform lain seperti Google Classroom dan WhatsApp. Penilaian terhadap speaking siswa tidak hanya dari aspek speaking di Google Meet, namun pada materi speaking siswa juga diberikan tugas menulis, dan tugas tersebut mungkin menggunakan google Translate untuk membantu siswa menerjemahkan dalam bahasa Inggris.
