THE EFFECTIVENESS OF MATCHING GAME TECHNIQUE IN TEACHING VOCABULARY AT THE SEVENTH GRADE OF SMP NEGERI 1 MUARA TEWEH SCHOOL YEAR 2019/2020

The design of this research is descriptive quantitative research, where researcher presents data in numerical and descriptive form. It is located at Jl. Ahmad Yani, Lanjas, Kec. Teweh Tengah, Kabupaten Barito Utara, Kalimantan Tengah 73814The population is students at the eighth grade of SMP Negeri 1 Muara Teweh. It consists 60 students. The researcher uses purposive sampling, the sample is students class A at the eighth grade of SMP Negeri 1 Muara Teweh with total 30 students. In this research given to students at the eighth grades each student get twenty multiple choice and essay question with A until D in the range of eighty minutes. The students' ability at the eighth grade of SMP Negeri 1 Muara Teweh have shown sufficient qualification in reading narrative text.Individually, 5 students (17%) who got 81-100 with rating quality is very good, 8 students (27%) who got 61-80 with rating quality is good, 14 students (47%) who got 41-60 rating quality is fair. And the last, 3 students (10%) who got 21-40 with rating quality is poor.Based on the research result, the researcher is trying to give some suggestion. first, the teacher should prepare the material to make the students more interested in learning English, especially in reading narrative text and then for students, they need to learn more about how to read the text of the narrative in English.

The use of matching in this game will make students feel relaxed, easier to remember and can improve students' vocabulary. Hadfield (1987:7) give some advice namely 1) a game must be more than just fun; 2) a game should involve 'friendly' competition; 3) a game should keep all students involved and interest;4)a game should encourage students to focus on the use of language rather than on the language itself; and 5) a game should give students a chance to learn, practice, or review specific language material. There are many benefits of using games in learning, the researcher hopes that the students can add vocabulary mastery.

DISCUSSION

The researcher use SPSS (statistical Product and Service Solution) to find out the effectiveness of matching game technique in teaching vocabulary at Smp Negeri 1 Muara Teweh, and especially to find out whether the students who have been taught matching game technique have better score on the post-test than the pre-test.

If the student's score of vocabulary test who are taught by matching game technique is not better on the post-test than on the pre-test, the null hypothesis (Ho) is rejected ,but if the student's score of vocabulary test who are taught by matching game technique is better on the post-test than on the pre-test, the alternative hypothesis (Ha) is accepted.

If sig (2-tailed) < 0.05 There is a significant difference between the learning outcomes in the c,pretest and post-test data meaning that there is influence of the use of learning technique in improving learning outcomes for vocabulary test.

If sig(2-tailed) > 0.05 There is no significant difference between the learning outcomes in the pretest and post-test data meaning that there is not influence of the use of learning technique in improving learning outcomes for vocabulary test.

Based on the data above, people know that the alternative hypothesis (Ha) is accepted and the null hypothesis (Ho) was rejected .Because the students who are taught by using matching game technique have better score on the post-test than pre-test. It can be seen from the results of data analysis that T-value higher that T-Table 12.573> 2.064 an significance <0.05 (0.00 < 0.05).

Based on the result, people know that the alternative hypothesis (Ha) was accepted and the null hypothesis (Ho) was rejected. Because the students who are taught by using matching game have better score on the post test than pre-test. It can be seen from the results of data analysis that T-value higher to T-table (12.573> 2.064) and the mean score of pre-test is 66.44, while the mean score of post-test is 74.20

From the results obtained and the result of the alternative hypothesis (Ho) is accepted and the null hypothesis (Ho) was rejected, the researcher concluded that the matching game as media was effective in learning vocabulary test.

CONCLUSION

Based on the result of data analysis as presented in chapter IV, it can be concluded that matching game can improve the student's ability in vocabulary . it from for the result of the posttest of the 7 grade, which was treatment using matching game got better score than pre-test which was without treatment using real object in matching game . So, matching game are effective media for the students to learn vocabulary in matching game.
